

Objectives for achieving Gold

1 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- To establish an effective coach mentoring scheme (linking with DSW initially but in the latter stages working with experienced national and international coaches/mentors)
- To ensure that levels 1, 2 and 3 (and working towards level 4) of the UKCC/NGB accredited Coaching Programme is inclusive, and that there is opportunity for higher level coaches to do qualifications and/or CPL that is impairment and/or classification specific
- To train and qualify appropriate Tutor Trainers to deliver DIT workshops within the Governing Body

PROGRAMME SUPPORT

- To have in post a Technical Lead (i.e. Head Coach) appointed specifically for the enhancement of disabled performers
- Evidence of NGB clubs achieving insport Club (or sport's own inclusive club accreditation)
- To establish a proactive performance development system, where talent ID and talent transfer for disabled participants is clearly articulated
- To appropriately identify and support bespoke support packages for all pathway athletes within the NGB
- To ensure that appropriate disability sport lead SSSM services are embedded in to the NGB system



7 ORGANISATION

- NGB Board proactively leads on elements of programme planning (responsibility for development transferred to NGB with support from DSW; funding streams managed by NGB, etc)
- To ensure that all policy shapes an inclusive strategic direction for the NGB, and participant and coach pathways
- Implementation of inclusive Operational Plan (Operational Plans should be representative of disabled and non-disabled participants and performers)
- To create inclusive club information packs that include a wide range of information available to Club Development & Performance Coaching Clubs, and available in accessible formats
- Attainment of the Intermediate stage of 'The Equality Standard: A Framework for Sport'
- To be capable of operating inclusively with support as required from DSW
